**Ruby** was the lucky winner of the raffle. She now has enough for a full tank of gas.

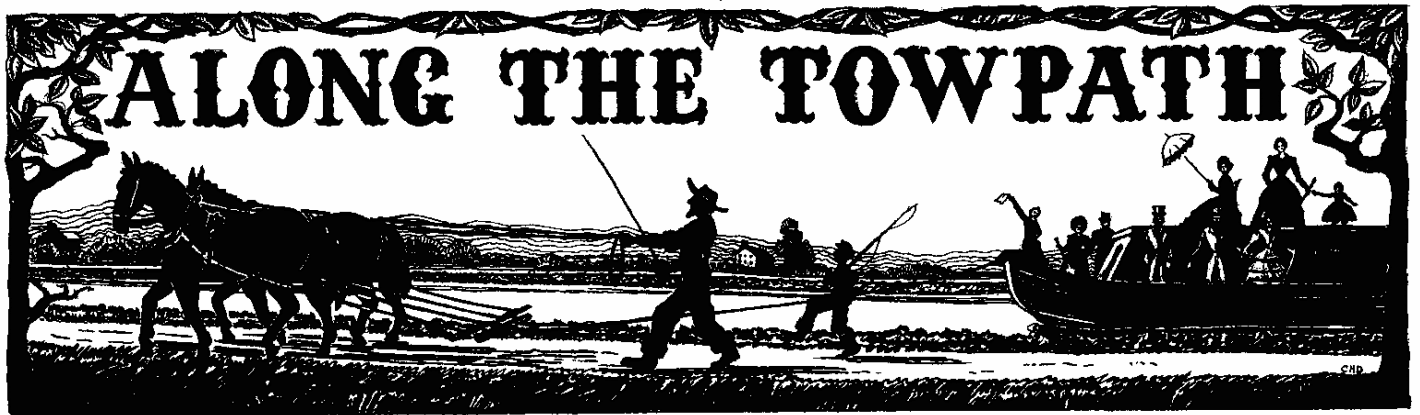
