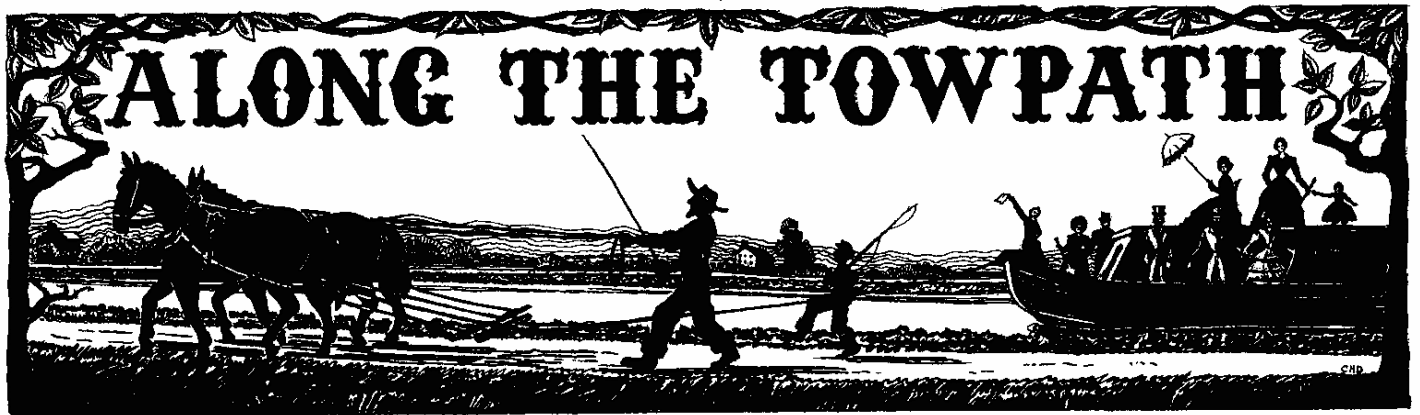
We have a busy week ahead for us. All members make an effort to show up next Saturday at Eaton, Vanport for the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Radio Auction.
