With the huge pot, Brian L was the lucky winner. He donated the money to our student. Kelsey will be able to purchase a gallon of gasoline.

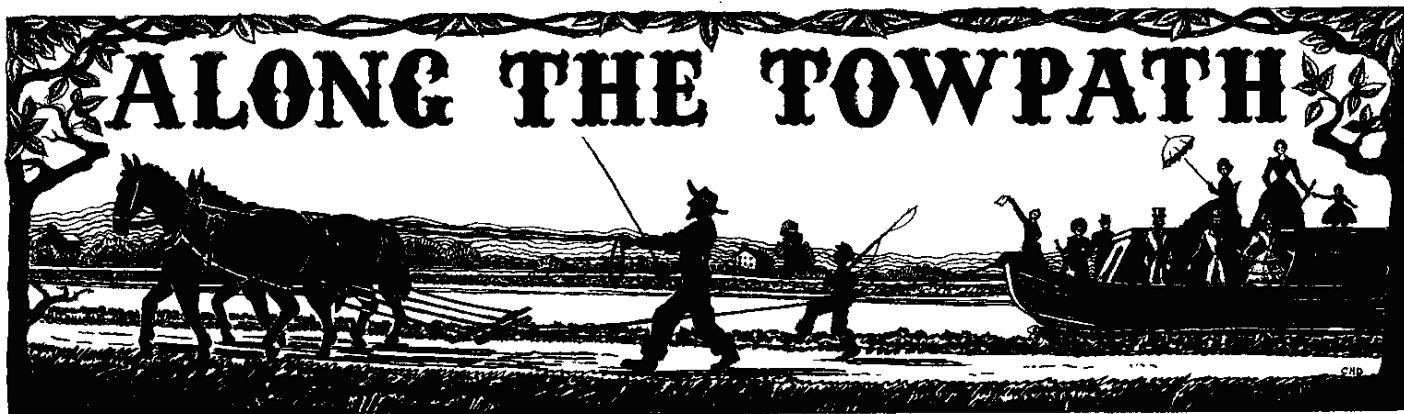
